


- 1. Please note that all sizes are in Asian sizes.
- Before printing, please ensure that page scaling is set to "None" on the print dialogue box.
- 3. Measure the bars on the right to ensure they are exactly 50mm and 2 inches long respectively.
- 4. If the measurement is not accurate, please ensure the page is printed at full size and reprint before continuing.



## Method 1: Measure the current ring

Size 6 14.0mm

1. Use a ring that is to be worn on the intended finger. The engagement ring and wedding band are traditionally worn on the ring finger, which is between the middle and little fingers.

Size 10.5


Size 11.5 16.0mm Size 13.5 16.45mm



2. Place the ring over the circle that is closest to the inner edge of your ring.

Size 9.5 15.2mm

3. If your ring is between 2 sizes, use the bigger size.






## Method 2: Using a paper sizer

- 1. Cut along the outline of the sizer carefully. On the left end of the sizer, make a tiny slit.
- 2. Wrap the sizer around the intended finger with the numbers facing out.
- 3. Slide the pointed end of the sizer through the small slit.
- 4. Move the sizer to the largest part of the finger.
- 5. Pull tightly so that the sizer fits snugly to the finger.
- 6. The number that lines up along the slit represents the ring size for the finger.
